

*The monument was manufactured at the Adams Granite Co. in Barre, Vt. It is solid granite, 40 feet long and weighs approximately 17 tons. The “Freedom Tower” in the center is 10 feet high and the eagle was sculptured from an 8500 pound block of granite. The eagle weighs about 1500 pounds and is 4 feet high. The sculpturing of the eagle was by Mr. George Kurjanowicz of Barre, Vt. It is a classic and the monument was delivered by Mr. Francis Tash of Barre, Vt. and placed on the foundation by Mr. Tash.*

*The basic design of the monument was done by Ed Ferguson and modifications were made at the recommendation of the committee, consisting of James Spencer, Reggie Monroe, Pat Welsh, James Gately Jr. and Rich Tousignant, representing the Adams Granite Co.*
